- **Camp Loud & Clear** – for deaf and hard-of-hearing youth ages 8 and older, July 26-28 at Holiday Lake 4-H Center

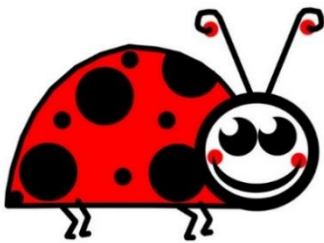

In addition to our overnight camps, we are excited to offer the following day camps:



Farm to Fork Camp 2019 – This is a day camp program for ages 9 and up. We will explore all things food including a “Farm to Table” component so participants can truly see where our food comes from. This will also include field trips to local farms, working in our on-site garden, and other interactive activities to go along with this theme. It will incorporate cooking while learning about nutrition and food science. This camp is planned for June 10th – 12th from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. each day. Cost is \$35 for materials, snacks, and transportation. Space is limited.

Bug Fest Day Camp- We are planning a day camp this summer on August 6th-8th. It will be from 9am – 1pm and based here at the Prince Edward Extension Office. It is for ages 9 and above. We will be outside discovering all the “critters” that live around us. There will be several “mini” field trips around our area to get a better idea of insects that live around us. We will focus on discovery and identification. The cost for this camp will be \$10 to cover materials and transportation. This camp will be a prelude to the “Hokie Bugfest” held in the fall each year at Virginia Tech. The group will be invited to attend this event on October 5th in Blacksburg on the Virginia Tech Campus. The cost of this trip is included in the cost for this program.



Food Challenge-Summer Edition- This program will focus on learning cooking skills in addition to a competition component very similar to the television show “Chopped”. It’s going to be held July 29th – July 31st from 9am – 5pm and be for ages 9 and up. This program will culminate on August 2nd with a Food Challenge cooking competition with other area teams AND another Pork Challenge competition in Smithfield on August 24th. This is an exciting offering! Please sign up soon to ensure your spot! Space is limited. The cost for this program is \$35 to cover a portion of the cost of supplies. Lunch each day is included.
